15. In Luke 22:14, how many apostles were with Jesus?
16. In Luke 24:42 what did Jesus eat, as well as the fish?

18. According to John 5:4 what did an Angel do every so often?

27. According to Colossians 1:14, through what do we have redemption and forgiveness of sins?
28. First Timothy 3:16 is one of the greatest verses concerning the deity of Jesus Christ. In this verse who was manifest in the flesh?
29. Does Hebrews 11:11 talk of Sarah's faith or Abraham's faith? (Should be Sarah's)

If you could not answer any of the questions correctly then sadly your Bible is translated from a corrupted Greek text. If you have a so called "modern, easy to read, up-to-date, Bible" then what do you make of it now? Pick up an Authorised Version (KJV) of the Bible and you may find the whole questionnaire a lot easier.

One Bible for life

How many Bible versions do you use? More than 5? Maybe you are one that does not believe it matters what Bible version you use, as long as it is easy to read. This sort of attitude should not be found with the true believer. When a Bible is produced with many omissions, with some being critical to core doctrine, then surely it matters if people use it or not? Would we not be horrified if we wrote something and people deliberately changed it and published it in our name? Just imagine what the apostles would feel like if they were presented with a Bible with some of their words chopped out and distorted. If you profess to follow the apostles doctrine then you should care about the Bible version you use. Why have anything less than the most accurate Bible available in the English language? (presently the Authorised Version, and has been for hundreds of years).

If you memorise scripture, surely it makes sense to use one Bible. Can you memorise more than one version? I would urge you to be 'fully persuaded' in your mind as to what Bible to use and stick to that. Do not use a modern (per)version that relies on the dubious minority Greek text as prepared by Bishop B.F. Westcott and Dr. F.J.A. Hort, but one that sticks to the majority of the Greek manuscripts found (The Majority Text – also known as the Received Text – received by the churches of the time).
